

Pick up an Ice cube with a string and salt experiment



- Ice cubes
- Salt
- Cold water
- String (about 20cm)
- Cup



1. Place the ice in cold water



2. Take a string and lay it over the ice



3. Sprinkle three pinches of salt on ice cube
4. Count till 30 (=about 30 seconds) and allow the salt to slowly wash away



5. Lift up the sting



The salt initially melts the ice, but once washed away the water freezes around the string and attaches the string to the ice.
